Beth Davila Waldman was born in Princeton, NJ in 1975 to a Peruvian mother and a New York architect father. Deeply influenced by childhood memories to construction sites and museums, Waldman pursued a career in the arts starting at the age of 15.

She earned her 1st degree in art history and studio art with a concentration in cast bronze figurative works at Wellesley College in the Boston area. She continued her education at the San Francisco Art Institute with a focus on site-specific public art and installation. During those years, her many travels to international urban sites as well as explorations of San Francisco alleys served as inspirations for her site work. She is currently working on a series of large-scale constructed mixed media paintings combining digital media with traditional paint inspired by her most recent trips to Peru, Greece, The Dominican Republic, and Northern Ireland.

Jon Fischer was raised in Pennsylvania by Israeli parents from Morocco and France. He earned degrees in bioengineering and philosophy of science from the University of Pittsburgh and a Masters in mechanical engineering at UC Berkeley before learning to screen print with a garden hose and a 60 Watt light bulb at CELLspace, the legendary San Francisco arts collective.

Fischer's current screen print studio focuses on large works on canvas, interactive screen print-based installations, and limited edition series. In 2014, his work was on display at the Florida State University Museum of Art, Marin Museum of Contemporary Art, and White Stone Gallery in Philadelphia. This year he will be exhibiting at Imperial Valley College, Secession Art and Design (SF), as well as developing a solo show at Vanderbilt University in June. Fischer's studio is based in the heart of the Mission district.

Born in Poland, Andrzej grew up during the years of political oppression during the communist era. There he attended the School for the Arts and Literature. In 1984, Andrzej moved to New York and received a BFA at Jersey City State University followed by a Master's Degree and Honorary Award in Urban and Landscape Architecture from the University of Pennsylvania.

After relocating to the San Francisco Bay Area in 1994, Andrzej began to integrate Eastern spirituality into his artwork. Andrzej's artistic philosophy led him to the California Institute of Integral Studies in San Francisco, where he received a Master's in Integral Psychology and a certification in Expressive Art Therapy in 2011.

While Andrzej's current studio is based in Berkeley, his paintings are currently exhibited Los Angeles, the San Francisco Bay Area, Chicago, Dallas, New York, Boston, Paris, London and Hong Kong. His work is in private collections throughout the United States.
